Frequently Asked Questions

What kind of training do the staff have in working with Autism Spectrum Disorders? All staff at Piece Together will have had training from Good Friend, Inc. of Milwaukee, in addition to training on the uses of a sensory room, and risk management training specific to Imago Dei Village.

My child has special dietary needs, can I bring food for him/her? Yes, if we are unable to meet the dietary needs of your child you are welcome to bring food along. Three weeks prior to camp we will send a menu to all families participating so you know how to prepare.

Will there be staff around to help ensure safety for my children? All families attending Piece Together will have at least two staff assigned to their family to help fulfill any needs the family has. Staff are there to be a resource and to ensure a safe and fun time for all family members.
