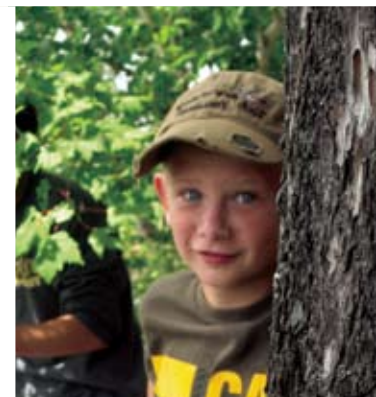

SIGN UP FOR CAMP

REGISTER FOR CAMP Campers must meet the grade requirements for their program of choice and have completed the grade listed as of the spring of 2011. NO exceptions.

Individuals may register online at CrosswaysCamps.org or mail in the registration form found in this brochure. **Families** registering for family programs should mail in their registration form. Sorry, no online registration for family camps at this time. Make sure to fill out BOTH SIDES of the registration form and include full information on all family members attending.

PAYING FOR CAMP Include a minimum **\$100 non-refundable deposit**, required for registration, with check or any major credit card. You may also choose to pay the full fee at registration. Final balances are due no later than June 1, 2011.

If a camper cannot attend their camping session a refund less the \$100 non-refundable deposit will be granted based on payments received. We will not pro-rate fees for late arrivals or partial attendance. Cancellations within one week of session results in forfeiture of fee, no refunds.

MORE INFO A registration acknowledgement will be sent via e-mail or postal mail depending on your indicated method. Campers will also receive a pre-camp checklist, health forms and information including program details, map, and list of what to bring.
