ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE: The retreat officially begins at 7:30 pm on Tuesday evening. **Participants may arrive as early as 4:00 pm – NO TUESDAY EVENING MEAL IS SERVED – plan accordingly** Please check in at Evergreen Lodge or the Dining Hall/Office Area. The weekend will wrap up at 3:00 pm on Friday.

LEADER & PROGRAM INFORMATION: We will have an avid quilt teacher in attendance for the retreat to answer questions you may have about quilting and to provide door prizes. A quilt shop trip will be available on one of the full days for those who are interested. Each participant will be provided with their own table. An additional table will be available to share for the use of cutting, as well as one ironing station per floor.

LODGING: Pine Lake Camp is located just south of Waupaca. A map will be provided upon registration. Quilting and lodging will be on both levels of Evergreen Lodge. Evergreen is Pine Lake Camp's adult retreat facility – complete with real mattresses, semi-private bathrooms shared with one other room, beautiful quilts, fireplace, and lots of places to relax.

MEALS: Pine Lake's very own chef will prepare delicious meals served fresh, well-balanced meals during your stay. If you have special dietary needs, health concerns, or mobility concerns please call camp directly as soon as possible after registration.

What do I need to bring to camp?

- Quilting Supplies – sewing machine, fabric, thread, rotary cutter, ruler, mats, pins, etc.
