




# THRIVENT ACTION TEAMS

Learn more about Thrivent Action Teams and if you may be a candidate for partnering with camp in this way!

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

All Thrivent clients with membership are eligible to lead a Thrivent Action Team. However, the number of teams each client can lead annually depends on membership type. Clients with benefit membership are eligible to lead two Thrivent Action Teams per calendar year, and clients with associate membership are eligible to lead one per calendar year. Associate membership is available for \$19.95 annually.




## WHAT TYPE OF PROJECTS?

Thrivent Action Teams supports three types of projects:

- Fundraisers: Purchasing supplies to be used to raise money for an organization. Host a Pancake Breakfast at your congregation, raising funds for camp scholarships!
- Service Projects: Your team can cover the cost of supplies needed to participate in a service project with volunteers. For example, your team can buy the stain and paint brushes needed to stain a cabin deck.
- Education Programs: Provide the supplies needed to host an educational program, such as workbooks, binders, or handouts for staff training.

## WHAT IS REQUIRED OF ME?

Camp Directors are ready to walk you through the process! We are happy to guide the application, talk through the project, including a supply list, and help you connect with other volunteers depending on the project. Each project requires different levels of participation, and we're happy to find the right one for you.



## I'M IN! WHERE DO I START?

- Yay! This is excellent news! Contact the Camp Director to confirm the need is current, receive details on the project and application, and work out a timeline together.
