Join us as a Workshop Leader this summer during Self-Determination Camp (August 10–13)! This program is open to young adults (ages 18–40) with intellectual or developmental disabilities, and we are looking for enthusiastic and engaging volunteers to lead fun, hands-on workshops. Workshops are about an hour long and can be anything you're passionate about—guitar 101, bucket drumming, creative writing, cooking, crocheting, or something totally unique!

You'll help create camp magic by offering new experiences that spark creativity, build confidence, and equip campers with skills they can carry into their everyday lives, communities, and congregations.

Examples of Responsibilities:

- Design and lead a 60 minute workshop (one-time or recurring)
- Prepare and bring materials needed (as able—let us know if support is needed)
- Create an inclusive, welcoming environment for all participants
- Collaborate with camp staff and support partners to adapt as needed
- Encourage creativity, participation, and pride in learning

Qualifications:

- Passion for your topic and a desire to share it
- Clear communication and a flexible, welcoming attitude
- Comfortable engaging with individuals with disabilities
- Age 18+ or accompanied by an adult
- No previous teaching experience required—orientation provided
- Willingness to adapt to camper needs and follow staff guidance
