

Covid Monitoring: 2022 Operational Guidance

Crossways looks to the CDC and the American Camp Association for information on best practices for mitigating Covid-19. Crossways staff will calculate our community level by state, not by county. More information can be found at: cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/science/community-levels

Directors will ensure that all staff follow facility Covid protocols outlined in the ACA Field Guide, including guidance for ventilation, distancing, and cohorting. The Health Center will have rapid tests available on-site for diagnostic purposes.

Guests and campers will be notified of the current Community Level at least one week prior to arrival at camp.

Low Community Levels (applies to summer camp and Crossways-led retreats)

- Masks will be optional in all locations
 - Staff will wear masks if requested by guests
- All staff and guests are highly encouraged to be fully vaccinated against Covid-19
- Tests will not be required prior to arrival
 - Unvaccinated staff must take a Covid test prior to guest arrival

Medium Community Levels (applies to summer camp and Crossways-led retreats)

- Masks will be optional in all locations
 - Staff will wear masks if requested by guests
 - Staff may advise guests to wear masks for close-contact activities or indoor singing
- All staff and guests are highly encouraged to be fully vaccinated against Covid-19
- Tests will not be required prior to arrival
 - Unvaccinated staff must take a Covid test prior to guest arrival

<u>High Community Levels</u> (applies to summer camp and Crossways-led retreats)

- Masks will be worn indoors, with the following exceptions:
 - When staff are working alone, or are outside, they may remove masks
 - When guests are in their sleeping quarters, or are outside, they may remove masks
- All staff and guests are <u>highly encouraged</u> to be fully vaccinated against Covid-19
- All staff/guests are asked to take a Covid test 1-2 days prior to arrival, regardless of vaccination status
 - *Rapid tests will be available at check-in for summer campers

Guest Expectations -- Guest Groups/Rentals

Guest Groups are those led and planned by groups or organizations instead of Crossways staff

- Group leaders are responsible for determining and policing protocols for their own group Protocols must be clearly communicated to attendees and Crossways staff prior to arrival
- When Community Level is High
 - Guests must wear masks when interacting with anyone outside their group
