

COVID MONITORING: 2022 OPERATIONAL GUIDANCE revised 12/16/2021

Crossways will look to the CDC and the American Camp Association for information on best practices for mitigating Covid-19. The board has approved the following practices for 2022. CDC transmission data can be found at https://covid.cdc.gov/covid-data-tracker/#county-view

Staff Expectations

All staff are highly encouraged to be fully vaccinated against Covid-19.

- Staff will wear masks according to CDC guidance based on transmission data.
 - When transmission is Substantial or High:
 - All staff will masks whenever interacting with other staff, volunteers, or guests.
 - When staff are working alone, or are both outside and distanced, they may remove masks.
 - When transmission is Moderate or Low:
 - Vaccinated staff may elect to remove masks
 - Unvaccinated or partially vaccinated staff will continue to wear masks
- Staff will verify their Covid status prior to the arrival of all guests.
 - Vaccinated staff may keep their status on file with HR.
 - Unvaccinated staff must show a negative test result from the 72 hours prior to guest arrival.
 - This test may be either rapid or PCR.
 - Unvaccinated staff may be required to find their own testing site.
- Directors will ensure that all staff follow facility Covid protocols outlined in the ACA Field Guide, including guidance for ventilation, distancing, and cohorting.

Guest Expectations -- Crossways Programmed Events

Programmed Events are those led by Crossways staff and promoted on our website.

- Guests will wear masks indoors according to CDC guidance based on transmission data.
 - When transmission is Substantial or High:
 - All guests will masks whenever interacting with other staff, volunteers, or guests.
 - When guests are in their sleeping quarters they may remove masks.
 - When transmission is Moderate or Low:
 - Vaccinated guests may elect to remove masks
 - Unvaccinated or partially vaccinated guests will continue to wear masks
 - Staff may advise guests to wear masks outside when doing close-contact activities.
- Guests will verify their Covid status prior to arrival.
 - Vaccinated guests may provide immunization status on their health forms.
 - Unvaccinated staff must show a negative test result from the 72 hours prior to arrival.
 - This test may be either rapid or PCR.

Guest Expectations -- Guest Groups/Rentals

Guest Groups are those led and planned by individual groups or organizations.

- Group leaders are responsible for determining and policing protocols for their own group.
 - o Protocols must be clearly communicated to attendees and Crossways staff prior to arrival.
- If staff members are wearing masks, guests must also wear masks when interacting with them.
- Staff will avoid entering group space unless necessary.
